1. MEETING OPENING AND CALL TO ORDER - 7:05 PM

ROLL CALL WAS TAKEN.

AGENDA WAS REVIEWED.

MINUTES FROM DECEMBER 6, 2010, WERE APPROVED AS SUBMITTED. (BANYAI/DUBLIN)

2. JAY GOLDBERG REPORTED ON THE NBC UNIVERSAL DEIR PUBLIC COMMENT MEETING WHICH WAS HELD DECEMBER 13, 2010. SOL AJALAT REPORTED THAT HE MADE PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING THE DANGER OF CROSSING CAHUENGA AND THAT THE TRAFFIC SHOULD BE MOVED TO LANKERSHIM. JAY GOLDBERG COMMENTED THAT PATCH.COM HAS ARTICLES ON THEIR WEBSITE REGARDING THE MEETING.

3. JAY GOLDBERG LED DISCUSSION ON WHAT ITEMS SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN RECOMMENDATION TO GTLNC REGARDING A COMMENT LETTER TO BE SENT FOR THE NBC UNIVERSAL DEIR.

4. MOTION – “THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS TO THE GTLNC THAT POSITIONS THAT THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE HAS SUPPORTED IN THE PAST BE INCLUDED IN THE COMMENT LETTER FOR THE NBC UNIVERSAL DEIR. REQUEST TO REMOVE THE TWO WESTBOUND 134 FREEWAY SIGNS DIRECTING HOLLYWOOD AND UNIVERSAL STUDIOS TRAFFIC TO EXIT AT CAHUENGA BLVD. AND INSTALL NEW SIGNS FOR THESE DESTINATIONS TO EXIT AT LANKERSHIM BLVD., AS WELL AS A NORTHBOUND SIGN AT UNIVERSAL STUDIOS DIRECTING TRAFFIC DOWN LANKERSHIM TO THE 134 OR 170. IF THE PROJECT MOVES FORWARD, WE WOULD EXPECT THAT FIRE AND SAFETY PROVISIONS WOULD BE MADE TO ACCOMMODATE THE INCREASE IN POPULATION AND ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES THAT WILL TAKE PLACE.”
