Discussion and possible motion:

Mr. Donald Anderson will join the committee and discuss his plan for a cannabis retail facility located at 4500 Forman Avenue.

Medex Flowers Cooperative Corporation LA Council File no. 21-0420-S9

Mr. Anderson presented his plans for the cannabis shop and allayed some of the stakeholder objections. He emphasized that there would be no cannabis use on site and security people would be in the shop and not on the street. The signage would be a simple mortar and pestle image.

The stakeholders were strongly opposed to a shop at this location citing traffic, security and value to the community.
