Shawn Besharaty: wants to be helpful to Nancy Gomez starting or joining the Neighborhood Watch. Asked her to please reach out.

Paige Cram F.: *Cahuenga and Valley Spring Lane has had many accidents at that intersection over the years. Hedge impedes sight for drivers.*

Tess Taylor: *suggests hedge to be trimmed by owner. Will assist Paige with this issue.*

Jonathan Gregory: *\$3,000 line item in budget for trash.*
